

**DeFuniak Springs City Council
Special Meeting Minutes

June 29, 2026**

Mayor B. Campbell called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. followed by the invocation and Pledge of Allegiance.

ITEM 2 – 54J RUNWAY WIDENING EXTENSION CHANGE ORDER #1

2.A. Change Order #1

City Manager K. Townsend presented Change Order #1 for the airport runway rehabilitation project in the amount of \$2,429,951.42. The change order includes the milling and overlay of Runway 9/27, replacement of the taxiway lighting, and the proposed westward relocation of Gene Hurley Road. He reported that the FAA had recently raised concerns regarding the road relocation. To avoid delaying the project, staff recommended approving the change order while withholding the Notice to Proceed with the road relocation until further coordination with the FAA. The runway and taxiway lighting work will proceed as planned.

City Attorney C. Adkinson stated the change order is fully grant funded, is not the result of cost overruns, and remains within the project's budget.

Motion made by Councilmember T. Bierbaum and seconded by Councilmember J. Sconiers to approve Change Order #1 in the amount of \$2,429,951.42, with the Notice to Proceed for the road relocation withheld pending further FAA coordination.

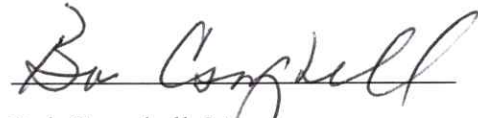
